Convention Chair:

2. What did you like about this year's convention (or the last one you attended)?
3. What did you not like about this year's convention (or the last one you attended) & how would you improve upon those aspects?
4. What is your experience in planning large events, communication proficiency, organizational skills, and creativity level?
5. What do you think your job as a Convention Chair entails?
6. Take one of your DCON theme ideas and further embellish upon your possible plans. Explain the theme, why you chose that theme, decoration plans, possible workshop ideas, possible guest speakers and entertainment, and any other aspects of Convention you have in your plan. Explain how your plans will make Convention memorable and/or unique.
7. **Required:** Please attach a portfolio that will help illustrate your convention plans (artwork for logo/t-shirts, workshops, decorations, etc information that will help people envision your ideal convention)

2. What did you think about this year's awards procedures (judging, Awards Night, trophies, etc.) What was positive, what could be improved upon and how would you improve?
3. How many Prejudgings and which ones did you attend? How do you plan on improving Prejudging?
4. Describe an ideal trophy design that incorporates one of your convention themes.
5. What do you think needs to be improved with the Awards Manual and how do you plan on improving them?
6. Have you done awards applications before (if so which one(s)?). Have you judged before?
